MASS FOR THE 2026 WORLD DAY FOR CONSECRATED LIFE - In celebration of this year's World Day for Consecrated Life, Archbishop Hundt will be offering a Mass for the intentions of the women and men in vowed consecrated life in this Archdiocese. The Mass will be celebrated on Monday, February 2nd, the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord - 9:00 a.m. at the Basilica of St. John the Baptist. 
