PRAYERS FOR THE HOLY SOULS IN PURGATORY

The beginning of November is a special time to pray for the Souls in Purgatory who are undergoing purification to enter the joy of heaven. The following plenary indulgences may be obtained for them:

- 1. On All Souls' Day: devoutly visit a church and recite an Our Father and the Creed.
- **2.** From November 1st November 8th: devoutly visit a cemetery and pray for the departed. A plenary indulgence can be obtained on each of these days, keeping the following conditions (if some of the conditions are not fulfilled, the indulgence is partial):
- **a.** Sacramental Confession within 20 days before or after (one confession is sufficient for several indulgences).
- **b**. Reception of Holy Communion (one reception for each indulgence).
- **c**. Prayer for the Holy Father's intentions (e.g. an Our Father and Hail Mary or some other suitable prayer).
- d. Complete detachment from sin (i.e. a sincere act of the will to renounce all sin).

The "Eternal Rest" prayer can be recited all year for the Holy Souls for a partial indulgence: "Eternal rest grant unto them, O Lord, and let perpetual light shine upon them. May their souls and all the souls of the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen."

<u>ALL DAY ADORATION, WEDNESDAY, NOVEMBER 5TH -</u> On Wednesday, Nov. 5th, St. Edward's Parish will have all-day adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. Adoration will begin at 10:30am and continue until 8pm. During this time the church will remain open for visitation and prayer.


